This is in reply to your submission dated March 27, 2013 addressed to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), which was forwarded to our Bureau on September 5, 2013, seeking acceptance of the subject product for use in food packaging applications in Federally Registered Establishments. The Agency requested the Bureau of Chemical Safety to assess the chemical safety of this product based on its chemical composition and its proposed use.

The subject film is intended for use in packaging of cheese under the following conditions:

- Temperature or state at which the food will be packaged: Chilled/frozen
- Temperature at which the packaged food will be processed: 10°C for up to 4 months
- State in which the packaged food will be stored or displayed: Refrigerated
- Temperature at which the packaged food will be reconstituted: 15°C for up to 30 minutes

Based on the information provided, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the use of the subject product as proposed, provided it is technically suitable for the intended end-use.
