Dear Food or Beverage Vendor,

As you may know, the State of California has changed the requirements for allowing Prop 65 point-of-sale warnings for canned or bottled food and beverage products containing Bisphenol A (BPA). As part of these new requirements, Dollar Tree Stores, Inc. must report to OEHHA any of these products that contain BPA for which Dollar Tree Stores, Inc. is the importer or distributor. These warnings are only affective for retail sales until the end of 2017.

In March 2016 we asked you to identify for us any products sold to Dollar Tree Stores, Inc. containing BPA. If you have provided Dollar Tree Stores, Inc. any additional canned or bottled food and beverage products since March or any canned or bottled food and beverage products not previously identified that contain BPA, please notify me of these BPA containing products via email at prioritychemicals@dollartree.com. In other words, please identify to me any BPA containing canned or bottled food and beverage either not previously identified and/or new items shipped after March 2016. This information is required by January 31, 2017.

The steps taken by Dollar Tree Stores Inc. are interim steps and Dollar Tree Stores, Inc. expects all vendors to come into or be in compliance with Prop. 65's BPA regulations. Dollar Tree Stores, Inc.'s actions do not relieve the vendors of their obligations, including indemnification, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the purchase order and/or vendor indemnification agreements.
